Cable ties may be used in place of Vistafolia® fixings when installing panels onto metal fences or railings. The number of cable ties needed will depend on the location and type of railing. Heavy duty, UV-stable cable ties are recommended.

TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USING CABLE TIES TO ATTACH THE PANELS

- 1. Use black heavy duty UV resistant cable ties.
- 2. Ensure the cable ties can hold at least 100lbs of weight per cable tie.
- 3.8" cable ties are not recommended they won't give adequate length or support per panel.
- 4. Use 9 heavy duty ties per panel (with allocating 3 rows of 3 cable ties) spaced out as you see fit, for adequate support to hold and secure the panels.


