UpScapers proudly sells and installs various mosses nationwide. Preserved moss is natural moss that is no longer living. Moss helps to purify the air by absorbing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. The moss also cleans other pollutants from the air. Moss walls are non-toxic, do not attract bugs, and do not require irrigation. Our installations have a 5-Year life expectancy, at minimum.

To ensure your moss wall's longevity and beauty, we've collected a few important details about preserved moss for you:



AVOID DIRECT SUNLIGHT



The most important thing to remember is that preserved moss walls should not be installed or kept in direct sunlight. Excessive direct light can dry out the preservative, bleach the dye, and fade the vibrant colors of your moss wall feature.



INSTALL AWAY FROM VENTS



When considering where to place your moss feature, keep in mind that they should be placed away from heating or air conditioning vents. Having direct ventilation onto the moss wall can damage the moss, and cause the feature to attract dust.

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MAINTAINING YOUR MOSS WALL

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AVOID EXTREME CONDITIONS



Ensure your moss feature is not in a frozen environment or a location with high humidity. Preserved plants may start to sprout in too much humidity. Conversely, with too little humidity, the plants could deteriorate and require glycerin water spray. They should be able to withstand regular levels of humidity, but excessive moisture will cause the dye to leak/run.



RELAX AND ENJOY!



One of the best features of preserved moss is not requiring any ongoing maintenance cleaning or costs. If kept in the proper conditions, they do not require any watering, misting, or spraying. In fact, dusting or vacuuming your moss can damage it and decrease your wall's longevity. So sit back, relax, and enjoy your new beautiful biophilic moss wall!
